People *hear our prayer.*

Give us grace to see the world as it is seen by you, that we may walk in the light of your love, extending your healing touch to every race and nation. We ask this through your anointed One, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
